I Trevor Morgan wish the following to be added to my will:

1. The copyright of all of my written works, with the exception of "The Saga of Sabah" be given over to a company limited by guarantee or similar and appropriate body corporate in perpetuity and may not form a part of the public domain.
2. That all income from said charitable trust shall be the equal property of my three children, Rebecca, Sarah and Matthew and their heirs and successors.
3. It is my express instruction that my work titled "The Saga of Sabah" be not published in any form within the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. A land that sees fit to squander young men's lives for the glory of the small men (and women) who are some of its elected politicians must see these small men (and women) dead and forgotten before this work may be published within it. Where poor John Keats wanted recognition from the likes of these I specifically reject it.
4. The copyright of "The Saga of Sabah" be given over to a company limited by guarantee or similar and appropriate body corporate in perpetuity and may not form part of the public domain.
5. That all the income from said company limited by guarantee or similar and appropriate body corporate shall be the property of the Malayan and Borneo Veterans Association and its successors. That said association may use any such income for the support of its members and the relief of their suffering.
